

LEAGUE CONDUCT POLICY

Ladies and Gentlemen-

It has become apparent that we are in need of documentation illustrating how we will not act while participating in a dart league or tournament match.

Players and teams WILL NOT harass the opposing team or opposing team's guests at ANY point in the match. Players are going to joke around, talk trash, and give the other team a hard time. It will not be acceptable to take it to the next level or to continue with this behavior after the opposing team asks for it to stop. We play darts, at a bar, and some choose to drink alcohol while playing darts. This is not an acceptable explanation for misconduct. This league will function and function well with fair play, sportsmanship, and respect. Those players unable to abide by this will be held accountable.

Anyone who puts their hands on another player or a players guest will be dismissed for the remainder of the dart year on the spot, Ability to rejoin the next year will be evaluated based on the situation.

Anyone who continues to harass a player on the opposing team after being asked to stop will cause their team to forfeit the entire match. The second time a player breaks this rule they will be dismissed from the league for the remainder of the dart year and that player's team will forfeit the rest of the dart session with all stats nullified. If this bothers anyone that the team suffers also, consider that you chose to have this player on your team and if team forfeits season, you chose to give them the chance to do it a second time.

Anyone who feels the opposing team is "sandbagging" needs to bring this to the coordinator's attention. Said player is not to act as an authoritative force in the situation.

You will come to know I will not tolerate behavior that muddles this league's reputation, or ability to function, in any way. Go out, play darts, have fun. Believe it or not, it is a game. Respect each other. Scream at yourself if you have to, but respect each other.
